1 st Quarter	Romans 1:16 For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto Salvation to everyone that believeth; to the Jew first and also to the Greek.
2 nd Quarter	Romans 1:17 For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, the just shall live by faith.
3 rd Quarter	Romans 6:4 Therefore we are buried with Him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we should walk in newness of life.
4 th Quarter	Romans 12:1 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.
